SWEET PALMETTO stalked the pace, circled the turn, was four wide entering the stretch, lugged in when taking the lead inside the eighth pole and prevailed under steady handling. DEAR RACHEL saved ground stalking the pace, eased out to the two path leaving the turn, bid for the lead between horses in upper stretch, was brushed by SOUTHSIDE MOLLY inside the three sixteenths pole, gained a short lead and continued gamely. SEEKING MILLIE , swung wide entering the stretch, rallied mildly. ELENA'S MASTERS saved ground disputing the pace and weakened late. CREDIT RISK , no threat, drifted very wide leaving the turn. GOOD GIRLS DONT saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. SOUTHSIDE MOLLY stumbled leaving the starting gate, dueled outside ELENA'S MASTER, drifted to the three path entering the stretch, brushed DEAR RACHEL when drifting in inside the three sixteenths pole then gave way. DOMESTIC ROSE , fractious in the starting gate, trailed.
