Footnotes

CLAPPING rated three wide in a stalking position, took closer order under a light hold mid turn, bid to engage the leader after a half mile, kicked clear when sharply roused left handed in upper stretch, widened in mid stretch then held sway under a drive. MARGARET OWNZIT dropped off the early pace while under some nudging, angled out leaving the three eighths pole, circled five wide into the stretch, straightened away and closed willingly to bridge the gap. STARDUST LILL, four wide in pursuit, made some progress into the stretch then flattened out late. BAZINGA B was rated back from between rivals soon after the break, dropped down towards the rail, was a bit tentative to go through a rail opening leaving the far turn, moved up along the rail in upper stretch, altered out leaving the three sixteenths pole but needed more between runners late. MELODY POMEROY chased the pace two to three wide, dropped back under urging mid turn, shifted out for the final furlong and had belated action. BOMBAY BEACHES sprinted clear early, set the pace towards the rail, was collared after a half mile, kept on to mid stretch then surrendered.
