RESCUE SQUAD ONE lacked speed inside horses, eased out three wide on the far turn, swung to the five path in midstretch, closed nicely and was along in time. MACHO STAR , three wide the first turn, advanced in the four path entering the stretch, gained a clear lead in midstretch then weakened late. OUR REPENT lacked speed, saved ground, eased out in midstretch then rallied. MR. E. , near the rail on the far turn, eased out two wide in upper stretch, reached contention in midstretch then flattened out. PENDULUM set a pressured pace along the rail and faded in the drive. BILLY CHAPEL prompted the pace outside PENDULUM, drifted out entering the stretch and weakened. NO BIGGIE , no factor, was outrun. GET MAD , three wide on the turns, gave way. SOLDIER FIELD dropped back in a dull showing.
