Footnotes

SOBER LIVING , taken to rate early while well within range, moved closer along the rail while under urging mid way on the final turn, angled out approaching the stretch, rallied under right handed encouragement, switched to her left lead when assuming command a sixteenth out then edged away. WHATSNOTTOLIKE cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, drifted out some in the vicinity of the furlong grounds, met the challenge of the winner soon after then gave way grudgingly. MY NAME IS RALPHIE lacked speed while off the rail, lost ground advancing four to five wide near the quarter pole, failed to sustain any serious run but did manage to earn the show. BETRAYED chased the pace while off the rail, was ridden along between foes after six furlongs, failed to go on and wakened in the drive. DANCING TIGER rated early off the inside, edged up three wide around the far turn, gave chase under strong urging past the three eighths pole, failed to respond and gave way. PLEASANT TIDE dropped back after a half.
