FLY SOUTH stalked the pace two wide, was nudged along mid turn, responded to left handed pressure inside the furlong marker, closed determinedly and outfinished ZIPATRON in the final yards. ZIPATRON cleared early, set a rated pace along the inside, moved away around the turn, was put to the whip near mid stretch, finished gamely but just could not withstand the winner's charge. MYLLILSECRET was taken back early and allowed to settle in last, saved ground while trailing into the lane, swung out near mid stretch and closed willingly. BREEZY BOY broke a step slow, raced under a snug hold early while saving ground, moved up a bit along the rail mid turn, chased the winner into the lane and came up empty. CAPIXABA broke slowly, was a bit difficult to settle when eager between rivals early, was put to a ride three wide around three turn then faded in the final sixteenth. DELAUNAY lost ground four to five wide and failed to respond. PHIL'S PROSPECT , off the rail, dropped back.
