### Footnotes

TAKE THE TRAIN broke with alacrity, quickly opened up, set the pace slightly off the rail and held sway under steady handling. LIVELY TIMES lacked speed, swung to the six path approaching the eighth pole and rallied late. CHANGE OF ATATUDE, reluctant to load into the starting gate, raced wide around the turn, chased the pace and tired in the drive. WORLDSERIESATATUDE, very wide entering the stretch, failed to menace. CLARA LIVES STRONG saved ground, chased the pace and weakened. SNOW PRINCESS in the two path between horses on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. PLAY LIKE A RAVEN, pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun. JUPITER RAIN, in the three path between horses on the turn, drifted wide in upper stretch and gave way. WILDCAT CONNECTION saved ground and was outrun.
