TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN hugged the rail, disputed the pace, asserted himself turning for home and pulled away while kept to his business. LEMON JUICE lacked speed, off the rail on the turn, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied. WILD LOUIS dueled outside the winner and weakened. JARROLD'S COMMANDO unseated his rider and ran off nearly three quarters of a mile during the post parade, hugged the rail down the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, angled outside in upper stretch and rallied. SPANISH OFFICER, two wide entering the turn, angled to the rail leaving the turn and faltered in the drive. THE ADMIRAL'SFLANK was outrun. RACE TO THE TOP stalked the pace, circled the turn three wide, stopped and was eased.
