SUZZONA , rated near the rail around the turn, eased out two wide at the head of the stretch, closed between horses and was along in time. TIGER FEVER opened a clear lead entering the turn, set the pace near the rail and gave way grudgingly. BATTINGSTAR circled the turn, was four wide entering the stretch and rallied. SHINE ON ME , two wide around the turn, rallied mildly inside horses. HIGH HILL lacked speed, swung very wide in midstretch and failed to be a factor. MY MISTY'S ECHO , three wide leaving the turn, chased the pace and gave way. MY LITTLE PRETTY , off the rail, was not a factor. BIG EASY hugged the rail and was outrun.
