Footnotes

WHATABOOTIE sprinted clear early, set the pace towards the inside, was taken on by CAMPAIGN VOWS entering the lane, held that rival at bay and held sway under a solid drive. CAMPAIGN VOWS was sent up between rivals soon after the break, stalked the winner two wide, moved to challenge into the lane, drew on near even terms past the eighth pole, continued willingly but was denied. LUCIANA, fractious in the gate, was backed out briefly before being reloaded, broke slowly, advanced along the rail nearing the quarter pole, shifted out in upper stretch and continued on with interest. LITTLE MISS NORA, greenly early, was steadied when in close nearing the turn, swung out five wide advancing in upper stretch, made a steady advance in mid stretch then flattened out late. ELITE HUMOR chased the pace, came four wide for the drive and lacked a rally. PLEASANT ASPECT was rated back from between rivals mid turn, shifted to the rail past the three sixteenths marker then had some belated action. ROCKET TOCCET moved up five wide nearing the half mile marker to stalk the pace, began getting out near the three eighths pole, ended up about seven wide entering the lane and faded. COUNTESS EMMA, three wide, faltered and was eased late.
