### Footnotes

DRIVEN BY FEAR prompted the pace two wide outside TYRAE, moved to challenge around the far turn, took over under urging mid way on the turn, kicked clear nearing the stretch then was fully extended to turn back SAINTLY LOVE. SAINTLY LOVE had his head turned at the break and was off a couple lengths behind the field, was taken wide soon after and moved up around the first turn to get within range, was put to a ride leaving the far turn, gained three wide into the stretch and gamely chased the winner home. TYRAE was sent up between rivals to take command into the first turn, angled to the rail when clear, set a slow pace, took pressure while under a ride leaving the far turn, relinquished command past the three eighths pole, chased the winner into the stretch and weakened past the three sixteenths marker. BRADENBROOKE was rated back off the leader nearing the seven eighths pole, saved ground in a forward position past the five eighths pole, failed to respond when called upon and tired leaving the three eighths pole.
