BROTHER SY assumed the early lead, set a slow pace near the rail, was set down in upper stretch and prevailed under brisk urging. GOOD REQUEST lacked speed, was angled to the rail leaving the far turn, chased the winner and closed ground late. OVECHKIN lacked speed, angled outside in midstretch and rallied mildly. BLACKBERRY ROAD, two wide, chased the pace and weakened. NIGHTSCAPE saved ground and failed to rally. TEMPLE RUN was outrun. SOUTHWEST lost ground on the turns and gave way.
