DISTORTED APPEAL settled back off the early pace while off the rail, edged closer three wide past the five eighths pole, responded well when called upon leaving the far turn and quickly accelerated to take command a quarter mile out, was taken on by DOUBLE EAGLE (ARG) in mid stretch, disposed of that one inside the sixteenth marker, drifted out late under strong left handed pressure and narrowly prevailed. SILVER TIE AFFAIR , unhurried early while off the inside, swung out six wide advancing into the stretch, closed gamely through the final furlong, drew even with the winner a few strides out but lost the nose bob. DOUBLE EAGLE (ARG) rated close while saving ground, steadied in close nearing the three eighths pole, worked his way out for room mid way on the turn, ranged up five wide to engage the winner in mid stretch, battled to the sixteenth pole then faded late. LONDON LANE prompted the pace between rivals, angled in entering the far turn, steadied when attempting to slip through along the rail mid turn, angled out in upper stretch, waited behind rivals in mid stretch, shifted back in leaving the sixteenth pole and finished with interest. DR. SKIP , four wide early, angled to the inside for the backstretch run, angled out five wide nearing mid stretch, made a run between rivals then hung late. POWDER MOUNTAIN tracked the pace three wide, moved two wide to challenge between rivals leaving the three eighths pole, forced the issue to mid stretch then weakened. HAY PRINCE , between rivals early in a forward spot, dropped back a bit near the half mile pole then failed to respond when called upon. PEACE FROG grabbed command early, set the pace just off the inside, dropped to the rail leaving the three eighths pole, was overtaken mid turn, continued to battle inside foes to mid stretch then weakened.
