**Footnotes**

HI POPPY lacked speed, raced wide around the far turn, swept to command approaching the eighth pole then drew off under urging. SNOW HILL , four wide the first turn, advanced three wide on the far turn to challenge for the lead and weakened the final furlong. CALVIN K , outrun early, swung wide leaving the far turn and passed tired horses. D'ARTAGNANS'SPIRIT , three wide the first turn, remained well off the rail and steadily weakened through the lane. RISING OF THE MOON , three wide the first turn, bid for the lead between horses leaving the backstretch, held the advantage entering the stretch and tired. WARRIOR PROSPECT drifted very wide entering the stretch then passed tired foes. FOG ISLAND was outrun. TREY BEAR had speed along the rail and faltered. DIAMOND DAVID , fractious behind the starting gate, prompted the pace two wide, held a short lead after a half mile and stopped midway on the far turn. PLATINUM MAESTRO stalked the pace inside horses and stopped.
