SILVERADO TRAIL , raced forwardly and under a snug hold along the rail, eased out three wide mid way on the final turn, rallied four wide to command nearing mid stretch and drew clear under solid right handed pressure. WHOOP! AGAIN prompted the pace two wide, lodged a bid to get on even terms around the far turn, dueled to the head of the lane then gave way grudgingly through the final eighth. MARINE CHARM , fractious in the gate, set the pace inside, dueled around the final turn and into the lane, held well to mid stretch then gave way. GO NOW , between rivals early stalking the pace, was put to urging three wide leaving the three eighths pole and gave way entering the lane. VILLAGE BAND lost ground three to four wide, raced close up to the far turn then weakened.
