PAGE MCKENNEY broke alertly, prompted the pace outside LASSO, disposed of that one near the three eighths pole, was put to brisk urging in upper stretch and asserted himself to increased his advantage the final furlong. MARRIAGE FEVER lacked speed, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn, had aim on the leader in upper stretch then failed to sustain his rally after lugging in near the eighth pole. MR. HANDSOME saved ground around both turns and failed to be a menace. LASSO stumbled leaving the starting gate, rushed up along the rail to take the lead entering the first turn, set a pressured pace along the rail, weakened on the far turn and faltered in upper stretch. WITH BENEFITS bobbed at the break and was outrun. STRATEGIC DEFENSE hesitated at the break then was outrun.
