LION ATTACK , unhurried down the backstretch, circled the turn, bid for the lead in midstretch and proved best in an extended drive. JIMMYMAC BEAR advanced along the rail entering the stretch, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, challenged for the lead between horses in midstretch and finished gamely. NO SUITCASES sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and weakened the final furlong. LAMUIM chased the pace two wide and weakened in upper stretch. MANDATUM , checked leaving the backstretch, raced wide turning for home. CHASIN TIGER broke poorly and was outrun.
