**Footnotes**

PRETENSION prompted the pace outside MY ADONIS under patient handling, challenged that one in upper stretch, was put to the whip approaching the eighth pole, gained a short lead in midstretch and prevailed under brisk urging. BRIMSTONE ISLAND , never far back, lost ground three wide on both turns and closed the gap late. MY ADONIS saved ground setting the pace, was put to urging leaving the turn, dueled in the lane and weakened late. RESPECTFUL ED raced in the two path most of the race and turned in an even effort. MIDNIGHT SERENADE , steadied when shuffled back soon after the break, saved ground around the first turn, was done after five furlongs and faltered.
