SIR RABBIT stalked the pace, advanced in the three path between horses leaving the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch then dug in late to prevail. HAM AND ERNIE saved ground stalking the pace, eased outside in upper stretch and closed nicely. ONE SUNDAY set the pace along the rail and weakened the final furlong. SHANGHAI KNIGHT saved ground most of the race and failed to menace. WILD AND WILEY, between horses in the stretch, was not a factor. OVECHKIN moved up in the five path on the far turn and tired. UNBRIDLED MUSIC prompted the pace outside ONE SUNDAY and gave way. SINGIN THE BLUES lost ground on the turns and gave way.
