R. BEE ESS saved ground stalking the pace, eased out to the two path entering the stretch, was set down in upper stretch, closed outside MISS SUWANEE to take command near the sixteenth pole then drove clear. MISS SUWANEE drifted in leaving the starting gate, sped to a clear lead leaving the backstretch, saved ground setting the pace and was out finished. HESAGOLDMINE lacked speed, was very wide entering the stretch and closed gamely. STAR MANEUVER , forwardly positioned early, turned for home in the four path and weakened in the drive. WON THE WAR , wide leaving the turn, failed to rally. SEVEN TEN SPLIT raced in the two path between horses on the turn and failed to be a factor. WALLY DID IT , along the rail down the backstretch, dropped back on the turn. MEDAGLIA'S EXPRESS , pinched back soon after the break, was steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch and failed to be a factor. SACHICOMULA , wide down the backstretch, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered.
