TRUE TO A POINT lacked speed, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch, swung wide approaching the eighth pole, closed steadily and was along in time. STAR MONEY , swung out leaving the turn, had a late rally between horses. DELTA DONYA sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and tired late. WINDY ANGEL , two wide, chased the pace and flattened out. POLISH DANCE raced well off the rail and was not a factor. I'LLTHINKOFSUMTHIN bobbled leaving the starting gate, pulled up near the half mile pole and was vanned off.
