ALSTON GUNTER prompted the pace outside TOBES THE MAN, closed between horses and was up in time. NIGHT OFFICER , steadied in tight quarters entering the turn, swung wide midway on the bend and closed gamely. TOBES THE MAN saved ground setting the pace and gave way grudgingly. PRINCE NOIR chased the pace three wide around the turn and raced evenly. JAKE RATTLE N ROLL , angled to the rail in upper stretch, flattened out. SANDBAGIN' LOVER saved ground and was not a factor. FLAVOR , outrun, swung wide in upper stretch. READY TO CRUISE came in on NIGHT OFFICER entering the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
