Footnotes

GIRON tracked a contested pace three wide, surged five wide past the leaders in upper stretch and edged clear under a drive. LOUANN'S BOOT set a pressured pace inside, dueled nearing the quarter pole, was overtaken in upper stretch and stayed on well. MOUNT WILTON settled back early, advanced three to four wide into the lane and found his best stride too late. LAMSTER prompted the pace two wide, moved to press leaving the three furlong marker, dueled into lane. SHINING PUNCH, off the rail, was ridden along around the final turn and faded. QUIET SEARCH broke in the air, moved up inside around the first turn, stalked the early pace and weakened.
