Footnotes

REVELATOR bobbed slightly leaving the starting gate, was steadied on a rival's heels entering the first turn, was patiently handled, hugged the rail the final three furlongs, got through inside several horses and drove clear late. OUR HAE , sent to the front, set the pace, raced off the rail through the stretch and was out finished. TRAPPIST MONK chased the pace two wide and finished evenly. CAPTAIN CRENCHE lacked speed, raced wide turning for home and passed tired foes. PRIVATE SAINT stalked the pace off the rail, was three wide entering the stretch and gave way in upper stretch. KLEITON hesitated when rearing slightly at the break, rushed up outside horses early, raced three wide on both turns, chased the pace to the stretch then tired. WESTERN SELECT was outrun. BREMO'S BLUFF , in close quarters entering the first turn, raced along the rail leaving the backstretch and gave way on the far turn.
