Footnotes

BEBOPING LION saved ground, inherited the lead entering the stretch, opened up in midstretch and held sway under steady handling. SHOCKRAHAWN , checked in tight quarters along the rail entering the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied. KENDALLS BEAR , steadied in tight quarters along the rail near the half mile pole, raced inside horses in the stretch and rallied. TAP KLASS , wide on the turn, floated to the six path entering the stretch then passed tired foes. CACTO CANTO circled the turn, prompted the pace and weakened in midstretch. ELDARION , wide on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. E. Z. PATH showed speed, raced in the two path on the turn and faltered in upper stretch. MONTY'S APPEAL , steadied when squeezed back soon after the break, was outrun and raced very wide turning for home. DYLAN THE DEPUTY dropped back on the turn and trailed through the stretch.
