DISCO DANDY sped to the front, set the pace along the rail under confident handling and prevailed under a late hand ride. ACTION ANDY , checked in close quarters along the rail when trying to get out entering the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and closed gamely. MY CUZ C J lacked speed, swung very wide entering the stretch and rallied. CLOSE TO THE EDGE circled the turn, advanced to upper stretch, weakened and was out finished for third. THORNY saved ground, chased the pace to upper stretch then gave way. DELAUNAY , wide upper stretch, was outrun. HESA BIG STAR , two wide around the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered in upper stretch.
