IRISH JULES chased the pace two wide and dropped back. KEY REALITY was no factor. RAINBOW FAME raced wide turning for home and was no factor. LISURA'S SECRET set the pace along the rail and faltered. KRYSIA gave way. IM NO CYNIC raced wide and gave way. FALLSTON VIXEN trailed. .
