Footnotes

TUFTON AVENUE , steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, raced wide around the far turn, opened up in midstretch and lasted under urging. REGAL MIRACLE raced wide and rallied. COUNSELLORS LADY disputed the pace outside IVORGET and faded. AMPLE'S STAR raced six wide entering the stretch and passed tired ones. TALEUR raced in the five path in upper stretch and was no menace. KUBALA'S KEEPSAKE was no factor. SAY DENIRO , steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, stalked the pace near the rail and gave way. PFILERUP , three wide both turns, gave way. IVORGET had speed along the rail, weakened and was checked in tight quarters entering the stretch.
