Footnotes

SKIPPER'S MATE , unhurried early along the inside, had clear sailing along the rail into the lane, moved closer in mid stretch, swung out, split rivals under aggressive handling, took command inside the sixteenth marker and prevailed. SMART N CLASSY prompted the pace along the inside, angled out for the drive, ranged up in mid stretch and continued gamely. PRINCESS HEIDI saved ground while settled early, got through along the rail mid turn, angled out five wide leaving the furlong marker, gained ground but was outfinished by the top pair. KEY STORM prompted the early pace three wide, dropped on the turn, raced six wide in the lane and kept trying. ELECTRICAL CARLITA came in a bit at the break bumping A BARRY GOOD ACT, sprinted clear and angled to the inside, was joined by WEE BURN into the turn, shook clear entering the stretch, was collared leaving the eighth pole and weakened late. RICO ENDS WELL , two wide on the turn and lacked a late response. BLESSINGS , in tight at the start, raced well back to the lane and failed to menace. OH SABLE , urged along three wide on the turn, failed to respond. A BARRY GOOD ACT , bumped at the break, lost ground four wide. WEE BURN , rushed up between rivals early, pressed the pace two wide to the quarter pole then gave way.
