BAT OUTTA HEAVEN sent clear early from the inside, set the pace two wide down the backstretch, began to drift entering the stretch, was straightened away briefly with right handed urging in upper stretch, drifted out badly when roused left handed leaving the eighth pole but was able to repel challenges and go back clear. TRUE SUCCESS broke in the air, settled in last while three wide down the backstretch, angled in around the final turn, advanced into the stretch, rail bid to threaten in mid stretch then hung. TEA TOTT stalked the pace three wide, was floated out a bid when lodging a bid in upper stretch then came up empty in the final furlong. STORMING MAUD , four wide, advanced under a ride leaving the far turn, chased five wide into the lane and faded. NANA'S LUKE was rated back after an alert start, raced between rivals nearing the far turn then had no response when roused. SWEET TIM broke a step slow, saved ground, faltered and was eased in the drive.
