THEDA'S SMILE saved ground around the first turn, swung wide leaving the far turn, swept to command inside the eighth pole, switched to her left lead near the sixteenth pole and drew out under a hand ride. IDLE TALK prompted the pace two wide, gained the lead in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. OPERA HEROINE , two wide between horses leaving the backstretch, eased out for the drive and rallied. SWING MUSIC set the pace along the rail and weakened through the stretch. AMERICAN VICTORY , along the rail in upper stretch, swung wide in midstretch and passed tired horses. MILLION SELLER saved ground stalking the pace and gave way. SHADOW LANE , extremely wide on the far turn, failed to rally. HANNAH'S DOWERY , steadied under the wire the first time around, raced three wide on both turns, stopped and was eased late.
