WAR PROSPECTOR , snugly rated early, hugged the rail, gained the lead inside INDY ANNESTESIA mid way on the far turn then pulled away under pressure. SIXTH AND ARCH , steadied in close quarters entering the first turn, saved ground, swung wide entering the stretch, remained on her left lead and came up empty. ROCK ON BABY , three wide both turns, chased the pace and weakened. FONT , wide the far turn, failed to rally. CROSS MOUNTAIN , no factor, lost ground on the turns. FERRY MUSIC , angled to the inner rail soon after the break, saved ground to the stretch and was outrun. INDY ANNESTESIA , sent to the early lead, set the pace in the two path and stopped in upper stretch.
