### Footnotes

THE DEVIL YOU SAY , well placed inside off of a contested early pace, responded when asked mid turn, eased out advancing in upper stretch, worked through rivals approaching the sixteenth pole, led soon after and dug in under a left handed drive. CLEARANCE SALE , four wide early, circled six wide into the lane, rallied to challenge a sixteenth out, finished gamely but could not quite go with the winner. DON DADDA was sent up soon after the break, duelled inside GO SIX GO to the half mile marker, rated back off that one and angled out to stalk around the turn, came back three wide to engage that rival in mid stretch, led briefly inside the furlong marker then gave way grudgingly. GO SIX GO duelled three wide early, moved clear approaching the three eighths pole, dropped in soon after, made the pace to mid stretch, duelled briefly inside rivals, had his rider lose his whip near the sixteenth marker then weakened. GRAND SLAM FRANKIE stalked the pace off the rail, circled five wide into the lane, loomed then came up empty. TED'S VISION , taken to rate while saving ground, worked well out into the track leaving the furlong pole then had some belated action. OPERATIVE , between rivals early, gave chase three wide around the turn but lacked a stretch kick. BLAZING CITY , pinched back at the break, lagged back, raced well off the rail nearing the lane and failed to menace. XYZAB , four wide around the turn, did not pose a threat. COLD SHOT , between foes near the half mile pole, gave way.
