MARIMBA MAN stalked the pace outside WIN TIGAR WIN, overtook that one inside the three eighths pole, was challenged by WHATDOYOUSEE inside the eighth pole, dueled outside that one late and narrowly prevailed. WHATDOYOUSEE , two wide the far turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch, bid for the lead approaching the sixteenth pole, dueled and lost the bob. INDIANA MOON stalked the pace inside horses, eased out to the three path near the three eighths pole, chased the winner through the stretch and finished gamely. SPINNAKER BAY , three wide the first turn, chased the pace, four wide the far turn, gave way in upper stretch. WIN TIGAR WIN , clear leaving the first turn, set the pace along the rail and faltered. MOUNT MERON trailed.
