SILVER SLUGGER stalked the pace, challenged for the lead outside LIONOFWALLSTREET near the five sixteenths pole, dueled with that one through the stretch and narrowly prevailed. LIONOFWALLSTREET , clear the first turn, set the pace slightly off the rail, was alertly eased outside a sheet of newspaper near the half mile pole, angled to the rail entering the far turn, dueled the final five sixteenths of a mile and just missed in a game effort. TO THE MOON , unhurried to the far turn, ranged up four wide leaving the final bend then finished evenly. CHANGING FUNDS saved ground, swung outside in midstretch and failed to threaten. PALO DURO CANYON , three wide both turns, chased the pace, lugged in near the eighth pole and faltered. FUNNY BOOK , outside horses, was outrun. NIGHTSCAPE trailed.
