Footnotes

NTOMBI , unhurried early, swung wide entering the stretch, took command in midstretch then pulled away under pressure. SMART GRACE saved ground disputing the pace, weakened and held the place. RESTRAINING ORDER circled horses on the far turn, was taken very wide entering the stretch and finished willingly. WITH FUN had a mild rally outside horses. ALPINE PASS saved ground and came up empty. WEEDER dueled outside SMART GRACE and gave way. NANDEN , no factor, passed tired ones. LICENSE TO SPEED was outrun. CARNIE'S DANCER , forced very wide by TRUE SENSATION entering the first turn, was outrun and raced wide in upper stretch. PASS THE VIRTUE , wide the far turn, dropped back. NASTY SABRINA was outrun. TRUE SENSATION bobbed and was steadied near the finish line the first time around then was taken up when bearing out entering the first turn.
