Footnotes

RIDGE AMOUR moved up two wide nearing the half mile marker to prompt the pace, sat chilly outside SHIP FROM ABROAD around the turn, moved to near even terms in upper stretch, dueled, responded to right handed pressure and edged clear the final seventy yards. SHIP FROM ABROAD quickly went clear, set a rated pace inside, took pressure from the far turn, dueled inside the winner past the eighth pole, drifted out late and gave way grudgingly. JUJU advanced three wide approaching the turn and stalked the pace, came under pressure mid turn, chased the leaders into the stretch but went evenly. JOEL'S TOUCH, four wide most of the trip, had a mild response. SARGE'S, off the rail, eased out some in upper stretch but lacked the needed bid. HAITIAN SENSATION was steadied back off of rivals leaving the gate, angled wide around the turn and failed to menace. DIRT DIVER saved ground stalking the early pace and weakened.
