HIGH CRY , in hand behind horses in upper stretch, advanced in the two path in midstretch, closed inside rivals and proved best. AGATHA K , in the three path on the turn, floated wide in upper stretch, bid for the lead then flattened out. KITTEN LOVE moved up in the two path leaving the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch and gave way in the drive. HEAVEN'S VOICE hopped leaving the starting gate, was wide in the stretch and rallied. PI BELLA , steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, swung to the six path approaching the eighth pole and passed tired foes. KRUSIN KELLY stalked the pace while wide and weakened. GRAZEZING bore out leaving the starting gate, prompted the pace outside QUEEN OF CHIC and gave way. QUEEN OF CHIC saved ground setting the pace and faltered.
