Footnotes

GENERATION SPEED opened up on the turn, was never threatened and prevailed under urging. FLYINGTOBECHILDERS circled the turn in the three path and rallied. CULPEPPER COLONEL saved ground and closed the gap late. GAMBINE ROAD , inside horses entering the stretch, had a slight rally between foes. RALLY FORTH , two wide on the turn, chased the pace and weakened. OVERCASTER , in the two path between horses on the turn, failed to rally. MISTER MEEHAN stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced wide on the turn and was outrun. THE ADMIRAL'SFLANK was checked in close quarters along the rail near the half mile pole.
