MARTINI relaxed nicely three wide while tracking a hotly contested pace, rolled up three wide to engage the leaders after a half mile, took over straightening for the wire, opened up when set down left handed and was kept to a drive to the final strides. OXFORD LASS lacked speed while off the inside, circled the turn four wide and kept on willingly to gain the place. DANGEROUS MAIZE dueled two wide through solid fractions, battled between foes entering the stretch, stayed willingly to mid stretch then weakened late. CALLMEWHACHUWANT lacked speed, swung wide for the drive and found her best action too late. SWEET MAXINE was sent up along the rail to take a short early lead, dueled, was put to a strong drive approaching the stretch, failed to kick on and tired through the final three sixteenths. GO MONEY GO chased three wide and gave way.
