Footnotes

BISHAMON lacked speed, raced along the rail in the stretch, swung out near the sixteenth pole, closed outside foes and was up in time. MONACACY WARRIOR prompted the pace outside FOCUS, gained the lead in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage inside the sixteenth pole then weakened. MIDNIGHT CALL, bumped by BREAKING UP leaving the starting gate, swung wide approaching the stretch and gained late outside horses. TIMBER THUNDER rushed up three wide on the turn, chased the pace and tired. FOCUS drifted out leaving the starting gate, sped to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and weakened in the drive. BREAKING UP came out at the break then was outrun after being, pinched back and steadied soon after the start. GAS TANK, very wide on the turn, was outrun.
