MAX'S PAL raced well off the rail on the turn, rallied in the two path and gamely prevailed. ULTIMATE WARRIOR set the pace, raced in the three path under confident handling in the stretch, was put to the whip inside the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. STORMIN OEDY was bumped and steadied leaving the starting gate, raced very wide and rallied. DONT TELL THE KIDS raced very wide in an even effort. GANGSTA RAP was checked in tight quarters entering the turn, raced in the two path and lacked a rally. SEJM BOOGIE swung wide leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. ALF saved ground on the turn, lacked a rally and drifted wide in the stretch. LOVESMELOVESMENOT was hustled along rail down the backstretch and was eased after being steadied in midstretch.
