CAJUN BAYOU broke slowly, saved ground under patient handling, eased out three wide entering the stretch, closed between horses and was up in time. DE CHERA dueled two wide between horses, opened a clear lead in midstretch then gave way grudgingly. OVECHKIN , very wide entering the stretch, reached a striking position near the sixteenth pole then hung. SHOW THE WAY , outrun to the stretch, swung to the six path turning for home then passed tired rivals. MONEY FOR LOVE , three wide the first turn, stalked the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn and gave way in midstretch. KING CONGO , three wide both turns, chased the pace and gave way in midstretch. VEER had speed along the rail, dueled around the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. IMPERIAL GIN , three wide entering the stretch, gave way. OUT OF OUR MINE stalked the pace well off the rail, angled to the rail entering the stretch then gave way.
