SILVERBULLETDAY saved ground setting the pace, opened up on the far turn, drifted off the rail entering the stretch and proved best while ridden out. DREAMS GALLORE saved ground the first turn, moved up two wide into the far turn and closed gamely. VEE VEE STAR, alertly angled to the rail approaching the first turn, saved ground, was jostled in tight quarters near the half mile pole, swung outside in upper stretch and finished willingly. MADISON'S CHARM, three wide the first turn, raced wide into the far turn, angled inside approaching the stretch and weakened. MYSTERIOUS JAK was outrun. THE HAPPY HOPPER, three wide the first turn, prompted the pace to the far turn then fell back. MAGIC BROAD raced two wide and stopped.
