SOUTHERN IMAGE , snugly rated outside MIDWAY ROAD, bid for the lead entering the stretch, dueled through the lane and drove clear. MIDWAY ROAD set the pace along the rail, dueled with the winner through the stretch, switched leads twice in the drive and weakened. BOWMAN'S BAND stalked the pace, raced three wide entering the far turn, attempted to drift in in midstretch and failed to rally in an even effort. EVENING ATTIRE lacked speed, raced in the two path and passed tired ones. DYNEVER , three wide the first turn, raced four wide entering the far turn and was outrun. OLE FAUNTY raced along the rail and dropped back.
