Footnotes

HONOR IN PEACE prompted the early pace from the inside, eased out near the three furlong marker, advanced under mild hand urging into the lane, moved to command a furlong out and edged away under steady left handed pressure. CHAPEL OF LOVE settled off the rail, commenced a run mid way on the turn, came six wide for the drive and closed well to earn the place in the final strides. RASHER chased the pace while off the rail, entered the lane five wide, continued on willingly but was edged for the place. MASS DESTRUCTION sprinted clear nearing the half mile marker, set a solid pace under good handling, entered the lane two wide, was collared past the three sixteenths marker and weakened late. CLERIC settled back towards the inside, raced three to four wide into the lane but lacked a solid finish. BROGUE chased the pace while extremely wide and faded nearing the furlong marker. TEMPERANCE TIME was outrun. AGAVE RIDGE trailed.
