DOROTHY'S DIAMOND rushed up between rivals soon after the break and put a head in front, dueled outside NO CROSSING LANE, was ridden along around the turn and maintained a short advantage in an extended drive. NO CROSSING LANE dueled inside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. BILLIONAIRE BOB, outrun early, circled four wide into the stretch, shifted out five wide and slowly gained. BREEZY TOMMIE saved ground while chasing the dueling leaders, angled out in upper stretch, closed the gap but was outfinished between rivals. BETH'S MARK, four wide early, dropped to the rail around the turn, saved ground into the stretch and closed belatedly. DADDYS CADDY, in close soon after the break, raced well back to the quarter pole, altered out past the three sixteenths pole but failed to menace. DADDY'S GABS, ridden along chasing the duel, raced three wide into the stretch and gave way.
