LEAD EM HOME, inside the first turn, steadily advanced between rivals leaving the far turn, surged to command in mid stretch, edged clear then held sway under a drive. RAIRE STANDARD, brushed leaving the gate, advanced two wide into the stretch, eased out in upper stretch and rallied gamely between horsed. STELLAR BRUSH, unhurried for six furlongs, circled five wide into the lane, moved up between rivals in upper stretch, altered course even wider late and finished gamely. HARRY'S HALO saved ground, moved closer two wide between rivals near the quarter pole, angled out and rallied mildly. RUSHING BRUSH, three wide early, advanced five wide between horses in upper stretch, drifted out late and hung. MEMORY TAP gained a short lead on the first turn, set a fast pace along the inside, edged away mid way on the final turn then weakened in the final sixteenth. ROLL LABEL raced well wide throughout, moved closer into the lane then weakened. SMART GUY pressed the early pace between rivals and gradually faded along the inside. MOON OVER PROSPECT chased the pace off the rail for six furlongs and tired. STRUBINGER (VEN) was outrun. STRAIGHT MAN, three wide, prompted the pace for seven furlongs and faltered.
