YES IT'S TRUE sped to the lead, set the pace along the rail, opened up in upper stretch then increased his advantage under steady pressure. THE TRADER'S ECHO prompted the pace outside the winner and finished gamely while no match for that one. PURPLE PASSION saved ground, came three wide entering the stretch, altered course to the outside in midstretch and rallied. GREENSPRING WILLY raced in the two path, steadied while behind ARTAX in midstretch and rallied from the outside. ARTAX broke slowly, rushed up wide leaving the backstretch, raced three wide into the stretch then was checked sharply and angled to the inside to avoid a patron leaving the eighth pole. BRUSHED ON, taken outside in upper stretch, was steadied and taken wider to avoid the patron. POWER BY FAR saved ground and was outrun. JUST CALL ME CARL raced wide and was steered clear of the trouble in midstretch. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run, it was decided ARTAX ran for purse money only and all mutuel, exacta, trifecta, superfecta, daily double and pick three wagers on ARTAX were ordered refunded.
