OCEAN DRIVE stalked the pace, advanced two wide entering the stretch, took command in upper stretch and lasted under brisk urging. FILM MAKER, unhurried early, swung wide in upper stretch and closed gamely. WITH PATIENCE, three wide the first turn, raced two wide between horses on the far turn, eased out for the drive and rallied mildly. CAUGHT IN THE RAIN, unhurried, swung wide in upper stretch and passed tired ones. SKIP TO SAVANNAH stalked the pace inside horses and weakened. LADY LINDA raced along the rail and was blocked in midstretch. LAVENDER BABY set the pace near the rail, ducked out in midstretch and dropped back. BLUFFIE SLEW raced wide entering the stretch and faltered.
