SEATTLE FITZ (ARG) was rated back from between rivals around the first turn, eased out and stalked the pace three wide, moved up under confident handling leaving the far turn, drew even nearing the lane, dueled briefly, went clear a furlong out and held sway under pressure. THE LADY'S GROOM , hustled to the front, set a pressured pace along the inside, was pushed along around the far turn, altered course to the outside leaving the eighth pole and continued gamely. ROARING FEVER settled two wide, was hustled along around the final turn but lacked a finishing response. DEELITEFUL GUY , unhurried early, made a mild four wide run in mid stretch then flattened out. WHITE BUCK , unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch but lacked a response. JORGIE STOVER , three wide early, pressed the pace two wide to the three eighths pole then gave way. YOUR BLUFFING saved ground and weakened. OFF THE GLASS put in a dull effort.
